



#### **BACKGROUND**

The CVQ, is awarded for the achievement of a set of competencies that define the core work practices of an occupational area, consistent with the levels articulated within the Regional Qualifications Framework (RQF)



#### CONTEXT

- CVQ's performance in Jamaica has been less than spectacular
- Prog launched by NCTVET back in 2007
- Introduced to MOE Schools in 2011
- NCTVET has been offering NVQ's in MOE schools from as far back as 1994
- CXC authorized to award CVQ's in MOE schools since 2006, not much has happened

- Standardization of content (CVQ) that is relevant to all partnering countries
- Core Units measurement, communication, entrepreneurship, and data operations need to be included
- Review CVQ for alignment => LM
